

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON AN APPLICATION FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT
SUBMITTED BY KYLE AND JORDAN BROWN OF BROWN'S SERVICES TPL, LLC FOR AN
OUTDOOR STORAGE USE ON PARCEL 529.04 (500 PARK STREET) IN THE VILLAGE OF
POYNETTE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE the Plan Commission of the Village of Poynette, Columbia County, Wisconsin will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, June 18th, 2019. The hearing will commence at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room at the Village of Poynette Village Hall located at 106 S Main Street, Poynette, WI 53955. The purpose of the public hearing is to consider the following: a conditional use permit application submitted by Kyle and Jordan Brown of Brown's Services TPL, LLC for an outdoor storage use on parcel 529.04 in the Village of Poynette.

The conditional use permit application and related site plan describes the proposed development as structures that will consist of: (1) a single-story office/shop building up to 8,000 sq. ft in size with future expansion up to 12,000 sq. ft. The building will include approximately 2,500 sq. ft of office space and up to 5,500 sq. ft of heated bays for work vehicles, tow trucks, plow trucks, etc.; (2) unheated three-sided storage building, within enclosed storage yard, for work vehicles and/or towed vehicles susceptible to weather; and (3) fenced in gravel storage yard for work related equipment, loading/unloading operations and temporary storage of towed vehicles.

A copy of the plans and application are available for inspection by the public at the Poynette Village Hall (106 S Main Street) Monday-Friday 8:00am-4:30pm.
