


# Yard Waste Program Burn Site Policy



Adopted by the Village Board: February 9, 2016  
Amended by the Village Board: April 22, 2019

The Village of Poynette Burn Site is located just off of Academy Street on the Columbia County Highway Department property. The site is a DNR licensed solid waste facility for open burning. Only residents of the Village of Poynette are permitted to utilize the facility.

## **Hours of use**

The burn site is only accessible by checking a key out at the Village Hall (106 S Main Street) during normal office hours, Monday through Friday (8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)

## **Items allowed**

- Brush (limbs, branches, twigs, and other woody vegetation)
- Leaves
- Garden debris

## **Items not allowed**

- Garbage
- Oily substances
- Asphalt
- Plastics
- Rubber products
- Furniture , including mattresses
- All recyclable products
- All construction materials (Treated or untreated)
- Stumps or root balls
- Grass clippings

## **Private contractor services**

No materials are allowed from any private residents, residential lots, vacant lots or commercial properties where a contractor has been hired to remove any tree, tree trimming, woody vegetation or leaves. This also covers private property owners who clear vacant lots.
