Alternate Side Parking – Between November 15th and April 1st, no vehicle can be parked between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am on the even numbered side of the street on the odd numbered calendar days and on the odd numbered side of the street on the even numbered calendar days, except as posted otherwise.

Snow and Ice Removal – All snow and ice shall be removed from all sidewalks, paved trails or paths within 24 hours after cessation of snowfall. The owner or occupant of property adjacent to a municipal fire hydrant shall also remove sufficient snow and ice from the area surrounding the hydrant.

January Christmas Tree Collection - The Public Works crew will provide Christmas tree collection on the first and second Mondays in January. Trees will need to be placed out by 7:00 a.m. of the scheduled collection date.

Brush and Bagged Leaf Curbside Pickup is the first Monday of each month starting in April through November. Please

Grass Clippings, Leaves and Other Debris clogs gutters and storm drains reducing the amount of stormwater that can move through the system. The accumulation of debris can cause flooding. Leave clippings on your lawn to naturally decompose and fertilize or make a compost pile or use the Village's brush and leaf curbside pickup.

Garbage and Recycling – The 2021 calendar is available on the Village website or copies can be obtained at Village Hall. If you have a question or problem with your bins being picked up, please call Village Hall at 608-635-2122. If your bins are not picked up on the scheduled day for some reason, please notify the Village and leave them out at the curb. The contractor may be able to return and pick them up the following morning.

Property Maintenance – The Village has several ordinances regarding the maintenance of property, junk accumulation, exterior storage of vehicles and recreation vehicles. Please be a good neighbor and keep your property neat and orderly. Complaints can be directed to Village Hall or the Police Department

Building Permits – Before starting any addition, alteration, repair, electrical, plumbing, heating, cooling or ventilating installation, moving, demolishing, or anything affecting the fire hazards or safety of any building or structure talk to the Village's Building Inspector about a building permit. Failure to obtain a building permit will result in increased application fees and citations.

Fences / Swimming Pools – All fences and swimming pools require a zoning permit issued by the Village's Building Inspector. Before starting work, please contact the Inspector for more information on rules and standards. More info can also be found on the Village's website.

Sign Permits – A sign permit is required for all new signs in the Village. Please contact Village Hall for more information or visit the Village website for application materials.

Utilities – Poynette utility bills (water, sewer, solid waste, and stormwater) are issued quarterly. Payments can be made online at the Village website, over the phone, by mail, in person at Village Hall, or by placing your payment in the drop box located on the Main Street side of Village Hall. If you cannot make a payment, please contact us for a deferred payment agreement.
