

## Garbage and Recycling FAQs



The New method of pick up will be rolled out October 1, 2013

Trucks with automated arms will now pick up the special made carts that will be delivered directly to your residence within the next several weeks

You may get rid of your old recycle bin, and old garbage containers by placing at curb side the day of your pick-up if you chose

Poynette's pick-up day remains Friday. Pick up for recycling is every other week, please see calendar below

The maximum number of carts one property can have is 4 recycle and 4 garbage carts. Small businesses or multi-family units of 6 or more are offered a 10% discount by Columbia County Solid Waste for a commercial dumpster if wanted.

Residents are provide a 95 gallon cart for garbage and a 95 gallon recycling cart

Anything left outside of these carts will not be picked up unless you have made special arrangements with Columbia County Solid waste for a pick up

You will receive one cart of each. You may purchase up to 3 more carts at \$40.00 a piece with an additional \$8.00 per month service fee

Starting Oct. 1 the new rates will go in effect. There is a \$4.00 a month increase in cost which will now total \$42.00 per quarter for the cost of recycling and garbage pick up

Each cart will have a Poynette Logo with an assigned serial number to track who the carts are assigned
